The Importance of Accurate Records

Removing eligible criminal records can have a positive impact for people and their families.

- Landlords and employers can search criminal records in approving renters or in hiring people.
- This can lead to bias against people based on the current records
- Removing these records can increase the opportunities to get a new job or housing.

What Criminal Records May Be Removed from CCAP?

In Wisconsin, records eligible for removal from the Wisconsin Circuit Courts' online public records database (CCAP) are those:

- When someone is charged with an offense that is dismissed
- Or for a case in which that person is acquitted
- Or the charge/arrest/case is older than two years
 - § if the charge is not associated with another charge that resulted in a conviction
 - § or if it was read into the record by a judge that it should be removed from CCAP when a case was dismissed.
- For records that are not for you (i.e., mistaken identity)
- For safety reasons, people can also petition the court of original jurisdiction to remove their
 personal information from CCAP in a civil case if they can demonstrate that a potential exists for
 physical or bodily harm or a threat of harm to themselves, a family member, or a member of the
 immediate household.
